Jamie is also a project manager in construction, "He is very hands-on, out in the field managing subcontractors and meeting with clients," adds E.J. Their youngest son, Sam is a landscape construction project manager. "Landscape construction is his specialty, which is a big part of what we do," explains his father, adding proudly, "He is also a fantastic tuna fisherman." This trio represents the solid future of one of the most successful companies on Cape Cod.

What about E.J. Jaxtimer's customers? "They're family too," says E.J. "Customers for life. As we build relationships with customers, many become close friends. Some go back years."

With a foundation built on family, success is sure to follow suit. E.J. adds, "You're only as good as the people you have in the field, you surround yourself with the best people in the business, honest, hardworking people."

E.J. and Terry are both native Cape Codders and have called Osterville home for over 30 years. Jonathan, Jamie and Sam were brought up here. From village streets to Dowses Beach to a day out on the sound with their Dad, Osterville is a part of who they are.

Beyond a commitment to quality, there is another constant thread beside the Jaxtimer name, charity. In and around Osterville there are reminders of the Jaxtimers' kindness and commitment to community. Armstrong-Kelley Park endures in its natural beauty thanks to E.J. and Terry Jaxtimer. The impressive flagpole on Main Street? Not only donated, but installed by the Jaxtimers. Main Street's center island (where the flagpole stands) is also maintained by their landscapers.

Standing in the heart of the village, the Osterville Village Library has also been the recipient of the Jaxtimers' community commitment. E.J., Terry and family donated administrative office suites to the new building during its construction in 2012 (Terry Jaxtimer was also on the advisory and building committees for the library), and have been capital campaign donors for the library through the years.

For years, E.J. and his family managed the Joe Cronin Memorial Jimmy Fund Fishing Tournament which earned the distinction of being the biggest private, one-day fundraiser for the Jimmy Fund at Dana Farber Cancer Institute. After









retiring as co-chairs of the Joe Cronin, E.J. and Terry founded the BIG 3 Fishing Tournament to benefit Big Brothers Big Sisters of Cape Cod & the Islands. The Big 3 went on to raise over \$2 million dollars in the six years they co-chaired the tournament. Most recently, the Jaxtimer family started their own charity events that include the Charter Cup Fishing Tournament to benefit local charities in need of funding and the Little Big Fishing Tournament which also benefits Big Brothers Big Sisters of Cape Cod & the Islands.

E.J. Jaxtimers' community outreach also includes an educational co-op program with Upper Cape Tech in Bourne, where E.J. serves on the advisory committee. The program provides young craftsmen in training an opportunity to learn from experienced Jaxtimer crews in the field. In 2021, they started a relationship with Cape Cod Tech in Harwich to expand their co-op program. From a business standpoint, it's a brilliant move as Jaxtimer gains a first-round draft pick for skilled labor while giving something back.

All across Cape Cod as you take a leisurely ride, spring, summer, winter or fall, you'll see them.

Gleaming red trucks out front with a crackerjack crew hard at work? That's a Jaxtimer home.

Whether it's a simple addition to a cottage or a six thousand square foot home on a waterfront estate, you get the same level of engagement, courtesy and respect with E.J. Jaxtimer.
